What is the PFA?!?

The role of the PFA is to provide cohesion between the school and the community through social and fundraising events and activities. We bring together parents and carers with the school to raise funds and have fun doing it.

The PFA works to enhance the sense of community at KMPS by (for instance but not exclusively) organising and running social events, creating opportunities for parents, teachers and students to enjoy and form good relationships. We aim to enhance the experience of KMPS students by raising funds used for additional resources. Funds raised by the PFA are intended to provide 'extras' not already provided by the school's main income – often 'fun things' that make learning more interesting and exciting.

The committee positions are unpaid voluntary roles. Committee membership last for a period of a year, after which the opportunity to participate would be opened up to new people.

Although the elected Committee take responsibility for organising and delivering events to raise money, these can't be done without the support of the whole PFA to help and support them.

There are no minimum or maximum time requirements from PFA members; everyone contributes their time on a voluntary basis. However, we encourage active participation of members to lighten the load for everyone; and ultimately to give us all a fair chance to enjoy aspects of an event with our own children.
